Also found in the documents of Chris O'Brian was the workers Lists for the First Annual Fall Festival. It did not state when the first Festival started but had a lot of the events that was like that listed above. The other work schedule had duties listed as construction of the Flag Pole by Joe Arvin who was the First Ruritan President and the erection of the Flag Pole, Amateur Hour Group, Camp Fire, Indian Dance Group Arrangements and each had people assigned to carry out these duties. The Princess of the Lake Ceremony was when the Queen came across the Lake and Landed next to Indian Rock which was a huge rock with a plaque on it and now a landmark in the Park. These events were not so much a fund raiser as they were just getting the community together to socialize and have a good time. It brought the community together and helped to build the community for what it is today.
